THE TERMS OF USE FOR FINLAND SOCIETY GRANTS

The Finnish Law of Government Grants (688/2001) is applied to the extent appropriate for Finland Society grants

The recipient of the grant agrees to comply with the following terms:

1. The use grants

The recipient commits her/himself to use grant for the purpose that is given in the application

2. Payment

The precondition for the payment is that the applicant has agreed to comply with these terms of use for the grant

3. Report

The recipient agrees to account for the use of the grant by the time appointed by Finland Society

4. Supervision

The recipient agrees to give correct and sufficient information to Finland Society so that it can supervise that the terms of use have been followed. The recipient also agrees to notify Finland Society without delay should any changes occur which can affect the carrying out of a project or the use of the grant for its original purpose.

5. Inspection and follow-up

In addition to what §16 in the Law of Government Grants prescribes on the right of supervision for government officials Finland Society is entitled to sufficient information from the recipient for follow-up reports.

6. Repayment of the grant

The recipient agrees to pay back to Finland Society without delay a grant or a part of it which has been given wrongly, without justification or excessively. The recipient furthermore agrees to return a grant or a part of it if it cannot be used according to these terms for the purpose for which it has been given.
